Additionally, the Chamber played an important role in getting more than a hundred IT equipment exempted from VAT.

Currently, the ICT Chamber has a membership base of more than 400 companies including both paying and non-paying members.

Overview of the Report

Over the past couple of months, Rwanda ICT Chamber implemented a number of programs and projects with the support of different partners. For instance, the ICT Chamber and the Ministry Of ICT & Innovation with the support of UNCDF implemented FintecHub, and MSMEs Go Digital Projects. Also, with the support of MasterCard Foundations, the ICT Chamber has been implementing the iHuzo Project in partnership with Access to Finance Rwanda/AFR.

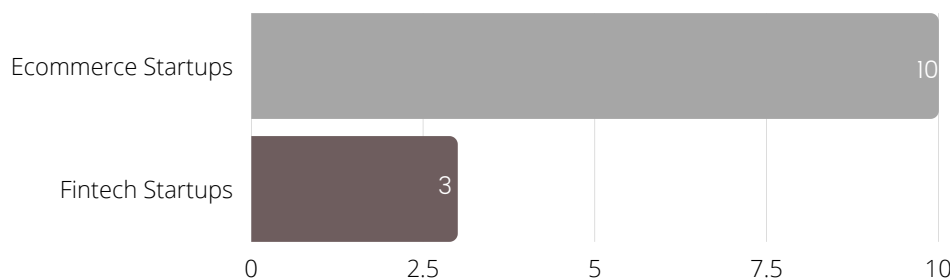

OUR CURRENT STATE

Rwanda ICT Chamber is a non-profit company limited by guarantee. If in any case there is any surplus at the end of a financial year, the company will always re-invest the acquired surplus in serving its members and the ICT community at large as is done with social enterprises to achieve its social impact

Overview

The ICT Chamber embarked on supporting and empowering more tech startups to be able to serve more users/customers. Particularly the ICT Chamber, through initiatives like the iHuzo project and FintechHub, disbursed grants to thirteen startups as per the chart below.



USD 58,500 of Grant

This is the amount of money disbursed to the three startups that were enrolled in the second cohort of Fintechub. Every startup had received USD 4,500 as a technical assistance and USD 15,000 as a seed capital.



USD 170,000 of Grant

Through iHuzo Project, the Chamber had disbursed 20,000 USD to five ecommerce platforms for an onboarding challenge, and also there is USD 150,000 to disburse to ten ecommerce companies enrolled in an acceleration program.

Access AIPI – International Partnership in IT

Access to International Partnerships in IT (AIPI) is a partnership project between Rwanda ICT Chamber and the Germany-based Bundesverband IT-Mittelstand e.V. (BITMi); Our common goal is to strengthen the Rwandan as well as the German ICT sector and to enable cooperation at eye level. In 2021, AIPI initiated various activities aiming at facilitating the creation of partnerships and access to new markets through B2B, study tours, capacity-building programs, workshops, exchange programs, and other events that support fruitful collaborations of and for both ecosystems

TechUpSkill Program

Tech Upskill is one of the programs of AIPI. Its main objective is to identify and support tech talents and innovators across Rwanda through capacity building and exposure. This year, the ICT Chamber through AIPI project launched the second cohort of TechUpSkill, and 221 applicants (male applicants were 69.7% and females were 30.3%) submitted their applicants of which 120 of them were selected to join the program. So far, 32 jobs were created from beneficiaries of the first cohort, and most of these jobs were provided after concluding the cohort with a hackathon that gave participants the chance to showcase their skills and competencies in front of employers.

BPO Program

The AIPI project helps German and Rwandan companies with matchmaking and arranges outsourcing projects by scaling up the co-sourcing opportunities. So far, 7 additional co-sourcing contracts were initiated. For example, Awesomity lab and Codeshift have initiated a business relationship, where Awesomity is co-working with Codeshift on various project opportunities.

Road to GS1 Rwanda

So far, two GS1 Workshops have been conducted namely "Road to GS1 Rwanda", in order to fulfill requirements asked by GS1 Global for approval of GS1 Rwanda. 11 flagship companies signed to take a lead in developing the business case and bringing their expertise together to put GS1 Rwanda application together with the support of GS1 Experts. the submission of application documents is aimed at the end of 2022.

ISQUI Training Program

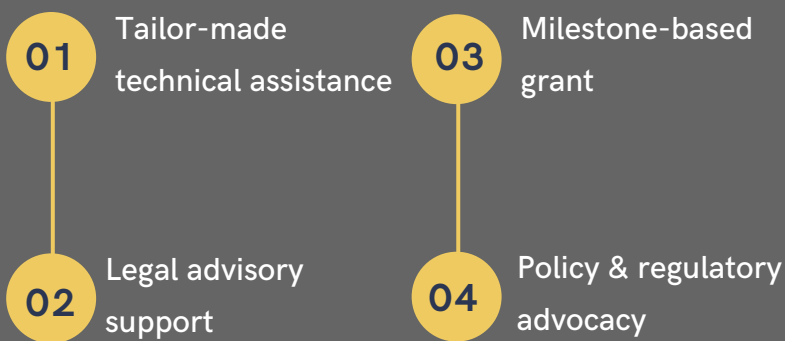
A total of 20 people took part in Certified Agile Business Analyst (CABA) through one of the training providers (iSQI), and 5 of these were women.

FinTechHub

FinTechHub is a 6-month acceleration program dedicated to supporting selected Rwandan fintech startups to scale by addressing their needs for skills, partnerships, access to capital, and navigating the regulatory environment. FinTechHub is an initiative of UNCDF in partnership with the ICT Chamber, Kigali Innovation City, MINICT, and MINICOM.

Key Outcome for the Second Cohort

Following the successful completion of the first cohort, FintechHub started its second cohort in September 2021 with three start-ups namely FoodBundles Ltd, Uplus Mutual Partners, and Urid Technologies Ltd. Below is the support that hub has offered to them so far.



Tailor-made Technical Assistance

Every startup received up to 4.5 million RWF to address specific needs identified during the diagnostic risk analysis

Legal Advisory Support

FintechHub serves as a central contact point to streamline queries and provide support, guidance, and relevant toolkits to start-ups, helping them navigate the regulatory environment.

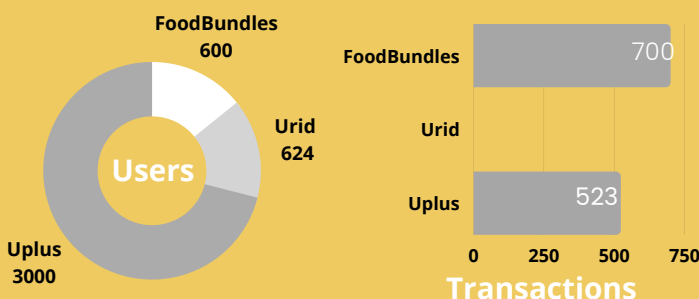
Milestone-based Grant

In addition to the funds provided as technical support, every startup received seed capital of up to 15 million RWF in form of a milestone-based grant.

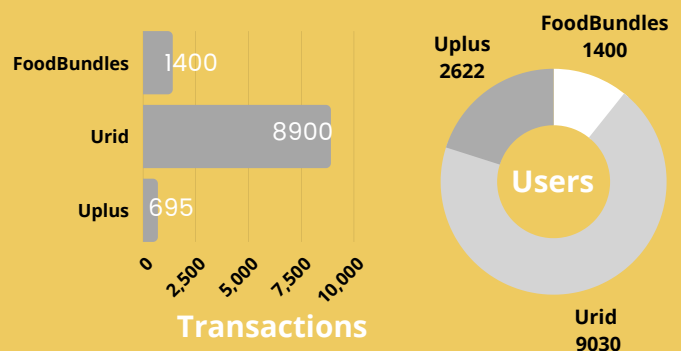
Policy and Regulatory Advocacy

Training of iWorkers

The iHuzo is a project initiated by Access to Finance Rwanda in partnership with the Rwanda ICT chamber, and it is funded by Mastercard Foundation. The project aims at accelerating the growth of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) by expanding the e-commerce sector in Rwanda to spur the growth of livelihoods and employment opportunities through e-commerce and promote an enabling market system for e-commerce by onboarding MSEs into the digital economy at the core.

Training of MSMEs and iWorkers

As of June 2022, 1357 MSMEs have been trained on digital trade. Also, 2208 iWorkers have been trained in different business aspects.

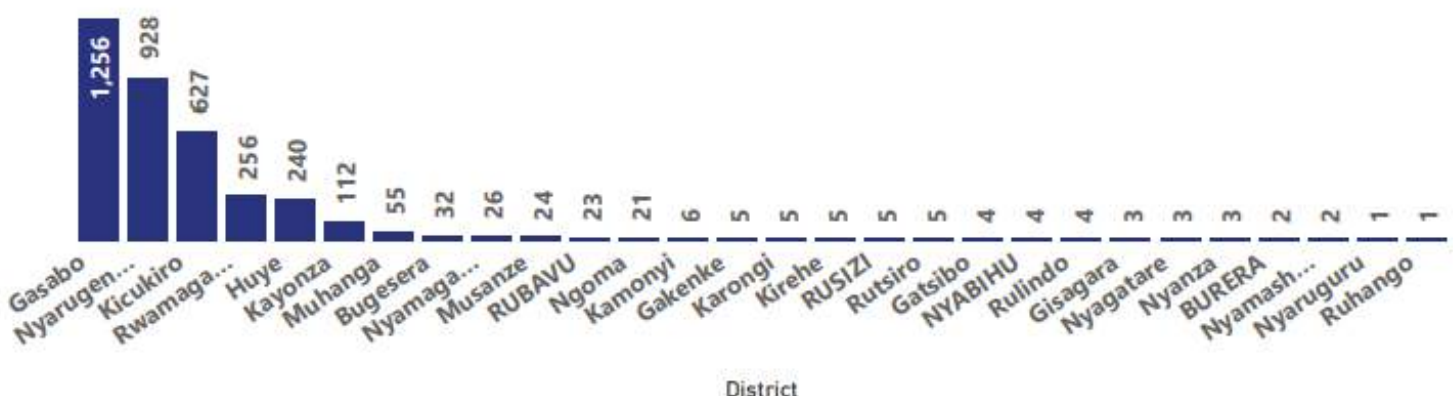
Ecommerce Onboarding Challenge

The purpose of this challenge was to give an opportunity to e-commerce platforms to come up with MSMEs onboarding strategies and receive funds from the project to implement them. Five platforms namely, Vuba Vuba, Murukali, Olado, Imigongo, and IDUKA were winners of this challenge. A total of 20,000 USD was given to these five eCommerce platforms, and they were able to onboard 506 MSMEs (new merchants onto their platforms)

Acceleration Program for Ecommerce Companies

The acceleration program is supporting 10 eCommerce companies that were selected after concluding an open call for application. The selected platforms to participate in the accelerator will be supported to grow their business capabilities, technical capabilities of the platforms, and business development. Additionally, every company will receive 15 million RWF to address its need for expansion.

MSMES GO DIGITALPROJECT

MSMEs Go Digital is a project sponsored by UNCDF, and implemented by Rwanda ICT Chamber in partnership with the Ministry of ICT and Innovation; the project aims to onboard more small and micro businesses on eCommerce platforms. Through this project, the implementing partners subsidized the e-commerce companies to reduce the cost required for MSME to join an e-commerce platform. The onboarding fees have been the primary barrier for MSMEs to get onboarded onto e-commerce platforms in Rwanda. Through this project, e-commerce companies received incentives in form of reimbursement for MDR costs as per the sales made by all newly onboarded MSMEs.

OUTPUT 1

Propelling Online Sales

In the context of boosting online transactions, e-commerce platforms were subsidized in reimbursements for their MDR costs; this helped propel sales of the newly onboarded merchant (mostly MSMEs). Since the beginning of the project in March 2021, the ICT Chamber had been subsidizing the MDR costs incurred by merchants for the use of e-commerce and reimbursed the eCommerce platforms an amount equivalent to **20,273,522 Rwanda Frans** for onboarding and supporting 1,500 MSMEs (new merchants) to transact online.

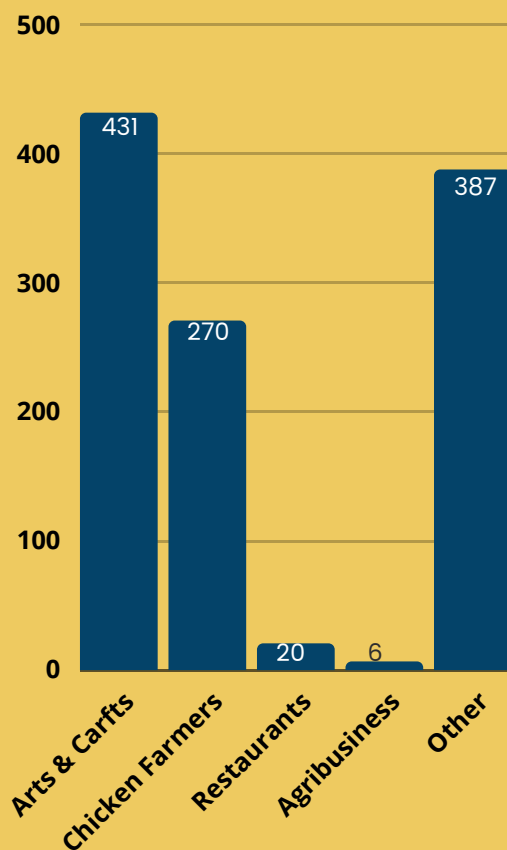
Awareness Campaign on Ecommerce

Different media houses were engaged to create awareness about eCommerce in general, but also to promote the adoption of digital payment solutions. The campaign was launched in May 2022 with the core objective of changing perceptions and building awareness of the benefits of using electronic payments. This campaign was branded "Twagiye Kashiresi" meaning let's go cashless.

1,500 MSMEs were onboarded on eCommerce platforms in Rwanda and started transacting online via eight different e-commerce platforms



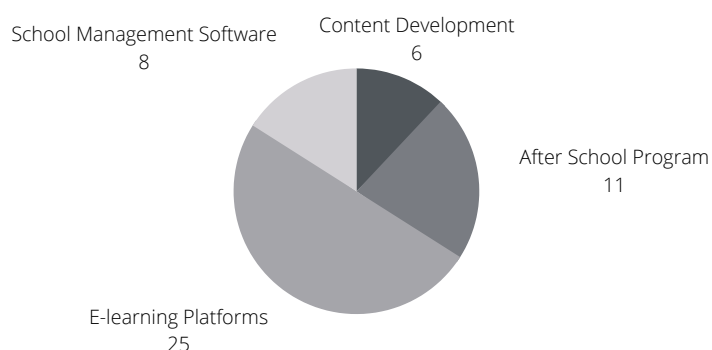
EDTECH MONDAYS



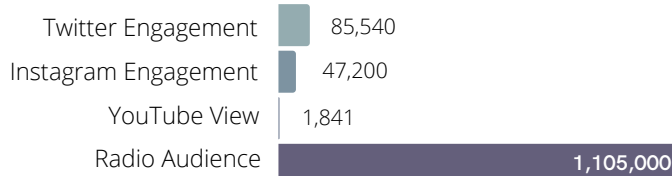
The EdTech Monday Rwanda is a Mastercard Foundation and ICT Chamber initiative that aims to spark the EdTech Ecosystem in Rwanda. The show occurs every last Monday of the month, and it airs from 6 PM to 7 PM on KT Radio and on Kigali Today YouTube Channel. The show airs in Kinyarwanda and it focuses on leveraging technology to advance education and learning in Rwanda.

Since 2019, the program has been driving remarkable impacts and enhancing EdTech innovations. As of now, more than 50 EdTech companies are benefiting from the program, and the number is still growing. The companies provide EdTech solutions in different components including e-learning platforms, content development, school management platforms, and after-school programs.

PROJECT REVIEW SUMMARY



The DBI is the capacity-building and certifying arm of the Rwanda ICT Chamber. Initiated and managed by the Rwanda ICT Chamber, the main goal is to support ICT companies in Rwanda to grow their expertise and build up capacities in needed areas. Through the identification of the actual needs and the targeted matching to capacity-building measures and resources for companies, DBI wants to ensure that the Rwanda ICT Sector has the needed capacity to compete on an international level.

DBI had set the foundation of a self-assessment as well as certification system and tested it with 20 ICT companies in a pilot program with the Ministry of ICT & Innovation. DBI is launching the full-fledged certification program that will focus on the sectors of software development and FinTech companies.

Furthermore, DBI has partnered with the Pan-African Ecommerce Initiative (PeCI) – a program executed by GIZ (German Cooperation), to develop an eCommerce Trust Seal, which will be operated.



FABLAB

FabLab Rwanda is a space for members to turn innovative ideas into products specifically in the hardware and electronics domain. The space provides a platform for capacity building and integration of hardware skills with software knowledge and quickly brings Rwandan innovators closer to the Internet of Things era.

Fab Academy

Fab Academy is an intensive six-month program that teaches students to envision, design and prototype projects using digital fabrication tools and machines to make almost anything.

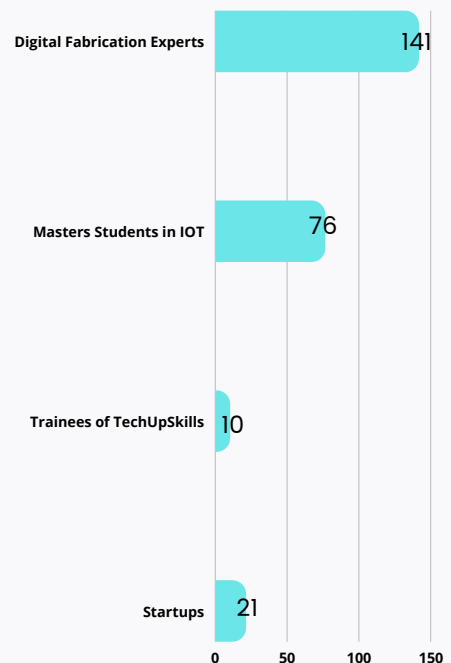
Fab Wood Initiative

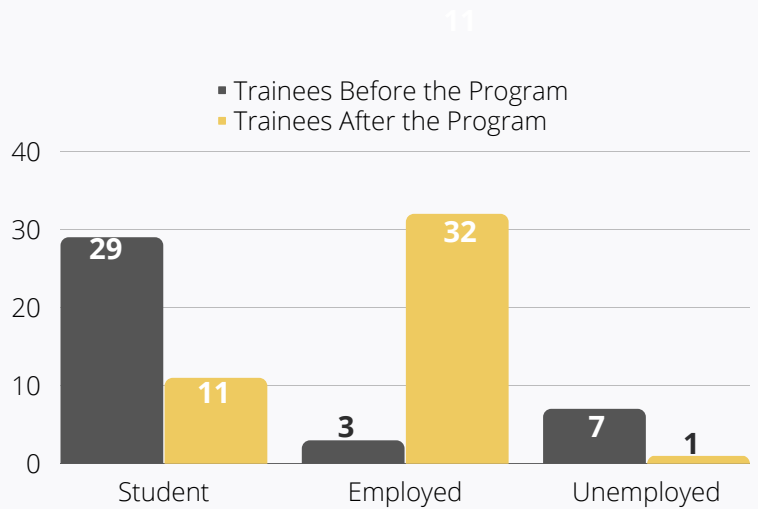

KLAB

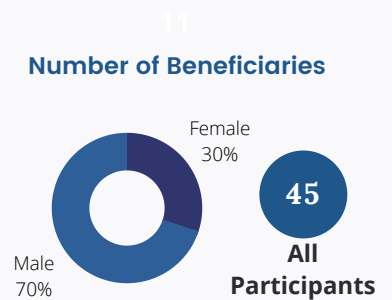

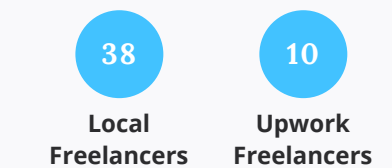
kLab Startup Academy

kLab startup academy received 200 applications and only 45 applicants were selected to join the program. Following the graduation of this cohort, 34 of the members are formally employed, and the 11 remaining members are continuing education in order to enrich their capacity for their future careers. 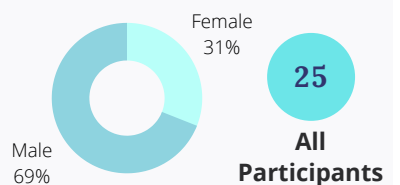
kLab Freelancers Program

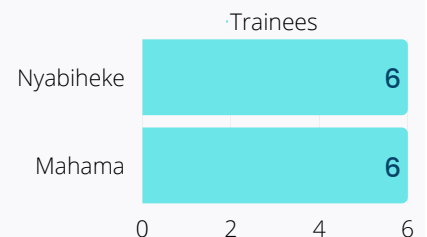
Future KODERS Program
